
Recover from Error Code E#78 (Multiple Node Failure)



Lesson Description

Error Code E#78 Multiple Node Failure occurs when nodes that were programmed into the 1756 DNB Scan List are no longer communicating. It always follows Error Code E#72, which is the first indication of a communication problem with a device. After Error Code E#72 occurs, the 1756 DNB will attempt to communicate with the problem nodes one more time. If communication is not reestablished, then Error Code E#72 becomes E#78.
